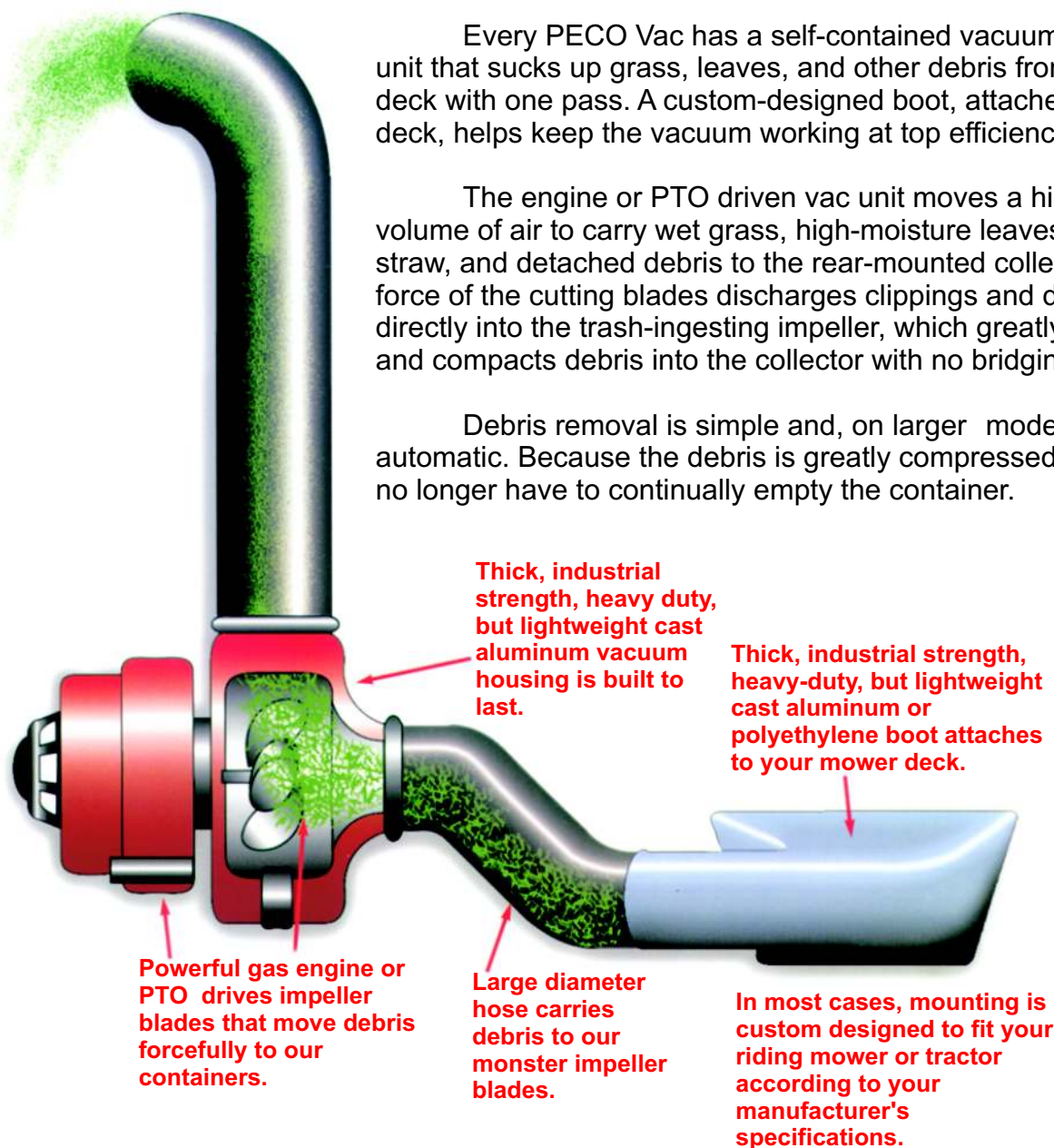
## How Does A PECO Lawn Vac Work?

Unlike baggers that depend on the centrifugal force created by mower blades to push some lawn debris into a container, the PECO Lawn Vac makes your entire deck a very powerful vacuum, very similar to your home vacuum cleaner.

Every PECO Vac has a self-contained vacuum power unit that sucks up grass, leaves, and other debris from your deck with one pass. A custom-designed boot, attached to the deck, helps keep the vacuum working at top efficiency.

The engine or PTO driven vac unit moves a high volume of air to carry wet grass, high-moisture leaves, pine straw, and detached debris to the rear-mounted collector. The force of the cutting blades discharges clippings and debris directly into the trash-ingesting impeller, which greatly reduces and compacts debris into the collector with no bridging.

Debris removal is simple and, on larger models, automatic. Because the debris is greatly compressed, you will no longer have to continually empty the container.



Powerful gas engine or PTO drives impeller blades that move debris forcefully to our containers.

Large diameter hose carries debris to our monster impeller blades.

Thick, industrial strength, heavy-duty, but lightweight cast aluminum or polyethylene boot attaches to your mower deck.

In most cases, mounting is custom designed to fit your riding mower or tractor according to your manufacturer's specifications.
