# SAFETY

- **1.** Read the operator's manual carefully and familiarize yourself with the proper use of your attachment. Do not allow anyone who is not acquainted with the Safety Instructions to use your attachment.
- 2. Know the controls and how to stop them quickly. READ THE OPERATOR'S MANUAL!
- **3.** Do not allow children to operate the machine. Do not allow adults to operate it without proper instruction.
- **4.** Be especially watchful of children and pets entering into the area while operating.
- **5.** Keep your eyes and mind on your machine while operating your attachment. Don't let others distract you.
- 6. Do not attempt to operate your machine when not in the driver's seat.
- **7.** Stop machine, shut off deck attachment, set parking brake, shut off engine and remove ignition key before performing any maintenance.
- 8. Inspect your lawn and remove any foreign objects before mowing. Never deliberately run the mower across any foreign object.
- **9.** Wear hearing protection.
- **10.** Wear eye protection to prevent debris from getting into your eyes.

**WARNING!** Do not work around the mower deck area until you are certain that the mower blades and the trimmer have stopped rotating.

**WARNING!** To avoid serious injury, perform maintenance on your unit; **ONLY AFTER STOPPING THE MOWER'S ENGINE AND WAITING FOR ALL MOVING PARTS TO COME TO A COMPLETE STOP.** Set the parking brake. Always remove the ignition key before beginning maintenance.

**WARNING!** For your own personal safety, ALWAYS mow ACROSS the face of slopes and NEVER UP and DOWN the face. NEVER attempt to mow excessively steep slopes, and use caution when turning on any slope.

# **BATTERY INFORMATION**

- General
  - Do not allow the battery pack or charger to overheat. If they are warm, allow them to cool down.
  - Handle with care.
  - Do not disassemble the battery.
  - Do not expose the battery to water or salt water.
  - Immediately discontinue use of the battery if the battery emits an unusual smell, feels hot, changes shape, or appears abnormal in any other way.
  - Keep away from children.
  - Always use the included battery box during operation.
- Storage
  - Store battery in a cool and dry environment away from extreme temperatures.
  - Battery should be stored charged.
  - For longer term storage battery level should be periodically checked and recharged as needed.
- Charging
  - Initial charge could take up to 2 hours.
  - Charge the battery pack only with the included charger.
  - Do not charge battery in battery box.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Allow battery to cool before recharging.

# **CHARGER INFORMATION**

- Red and green light will display when charger is plugged in
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Green light will turn off and fan will come on when charging.
  - Green light will illuminate once charging is complete.
- Charger has 2 fuses; one in the front behind the screw head and one behind the AC power input.
  - Always disconnect charger from power supply before checking fuses.
  - A blown front fuse will result in both lights illuminating and will not allow batteries to charge or fan to run.
  - A blown rear fuse will result in no lights illuminated and no charging.

### **Section 1 Introduction**

Thank you for purchasing the newly released PECO Z-Trimmer Pro model number ZT-5000. We took all the great features our customers have grown to love, and improved them for greater durability and performance.

The Z-Trimmer Pro is an attachment for your riding mower, zero-turn mower, stand on mower or tractor, that allows you to trim and mow at the same time. Your productivity and efficiency will improve and you will save time and labor.

The Z-Trimmer Pro comes with an 84 volt battery and should be allowed to charge fully before initial use for maximum performance.

The trimmer line should be no longer than 16". Longer lengths will cause excessive power consumption and reduce the efficiency of the trimmer.

The 140 degree breakaway action of the Z-Trimmer Pro is intended to provide relief when hitting objects. Many mowers travel at speeds of 10+ MPH. At speeds greater than 2 MPH, hitting objects with the Z-Trimmer Pro <u>will</u> cause damage to the unit. Trimming at higher speeds will decrease quality of the cut.



<u>NOTE:</u> Always wear the proper personal protection equipment when operating the PECO Z-Trimmer Pro.





### Section 2 Mounting Instructions

**NOTE:** The Z-Trimmer Pro is designed to fit most styles of mowing decks. We recommend using 4 mounting holes to secure the Z-Trimmer Pro to the mowing deck. The style of mowing deck on your machine will determine which mounting holes you will use.

Before drilling any holes into your mowing deck, locate the best position for the Z-Trimmer Pro. Things you should consider before drilling any holes:

- Clearance for the Z-Trimmer Pro in both the up and down positions.
- Accessibility to the handle from the operator's seat.
- •Distance between the trimmer head and the mowing deck when the Z-Trimmer Pro is in the engaged position.
- Check for possible blade interference.

Place the Z-Trimmer Pro to the side of the mowing deck opposite of the grass discharge chute. Position the base plate so that the plate is flush with the edge of the deck and on center. Once in position, mark four holes from the base plate onto your mowing deck. Drill the holes with a 1/4" (.250-.257) drill bit. Secure the Z-Trimmer Pro to the mower deck using (4) 1/4"-20 x 1" Hex Bolts P#(K1125) and (4) 1/4"-20 Nylon Flange Locknuts P#(K2014). Refer to Figure A and B.



Route the power cable before connecting the cable to the battery. After the Z-trimmer Pro has been secured to the mowing deck route the cable around the outside of the operator seat so that the cable does not interfere with the seat or the control arms. Before connecting the power cable to the battery ensure the power switch is in the off position. Keep cable away from all heat sources and moving parts. Use zip-ties to secure the power cable, once the best routing has been determined.

### Section 3 Operating Instructions

When not in use the Z-Trimmer Pro should be in the upright position with the latch hook secured. See Figure A.

#### **Trimming**

1. Release the latch hook and lower the trimmer into the down position. Refer to Figure B.



#### Trimming (cont.)

#### **Edging**

To activate trimmer head flip the switch to the ( I ) position. To de-activate the trimmer head flip the switch to the ( O ) position. Refer to Figure A.



To position the trimmer head for edging, loosen the star knob shown in Figure B, rotate the trimmer head into the position desired for edging and retighten the star knob.



### **Section 4 Height Adjustment**

While in the down position, adjust the height of the trimmer head so that it is in line with the blades on the mower deck.



For fine tuning adjustment of the height, use the adjustment bolt shown in Figure D. Turn the bolt clockwise to lower the swing arm, or counter-clockwise to raise the swing arm.

### Section 5 Trimmer Line

To replace trimmer line, bend a new 16" precut line into two equal lengths, insert the line ends into the holes on the trimmer head. The head will automatically route the line out the correct hole. Pull each end taught and adjust if uneven. Refer to Figure A.

Any 0.095"- 0.135" line is acceptable however to order more of the included trimmer line P#(ZT-0129), contact PECO at (800) 438-5823.



### Section 6 Battery Box Mounting

The Battery Box is designed to fit most styles of mower ROPS however it can be mounted anywhere that is suitable. Ensure the included battery extension cable can reach and will be free of any interference before securing.

Secure the Battery Box using (4) 5/16 "-18 x 3" Hex Bolts P#(K1472) (4) 5/16"-18 Nylon Flange Locknuts P#(K2516) and (2) Battery Box Clamps P#(ZT-0126)





### **Section 7 Connecting the Battery**

With the Z-Trimmer Pro and Battery Box secured ensure the power switch is in the off position and connect the Battery (ZT-0127) to the Battery Extension Harness (ZT-0130) aligning the flat edges of both terminals and tightening the securing nut. Refer to figures A and B.

To charge the battery first disconnect it from the battery harness and remove the battery from the battery box. Allow battery to cool if warm. Next connect the Battery to the Battery Charger (ZT-0128) as previously described above. Do not leave battery unattended while charging.

Once connected a red LED will come on to indicate the battery is charging. A second green LED will come on once charging is complete. Battery can be disconnected at this time.



### Section 8 Tips and Recommendations

- Inspect the Z-Trimmer Pro before each and every use. Examine the base plate to ensure the Z-Trimmer Pro is tightly secured to your machine. Make sure the power cable is secure. Check all moving parts for damage or obstruction. Inspect the trimmer head and line.
- Check the head shroud for any debris before using the Z-Trimmer Pro. Clean if necessary.
- Keep your trimmer line in an easily accessible, but secure place on your machine. Practice replacing the trimmer line from the operator seat to save time.
- If the Z-Trimmer Pro gets hung up or caught on something, **STOP** and **TURN THE POWER OFF** before inspecting the situation.
- Ensure the Z-Trimmer Pro is in the correct angle (trimming/edging) and that the star knob is tightened securely before use.
- Always inspect the area you are trimming before operating your Z-Trimmer Pro. Look for anything that could potentially get caught up in the trimmer head, or damage the trimmer.
